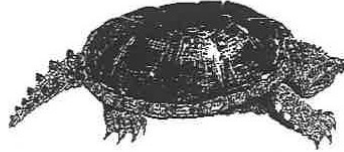
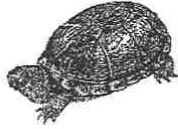


EIGHTH ANNUAL TENNESSEE HERPETOLOGY CONFERENCE
